

Proper Diet is also very important for a safe, healthy and successful season

Any pre-existing medical conditions (asthma, allergic reactions, etc.) should be listed on your child's 2021 physical form. Safety is #1!

• There is a difference between being "hurt" and being "injured" All INJURIES (concussion, severe sprains, fractures) need to be brought to the attention of your team's Head Coach and one of our Safety Staff.

Every INJURY will require an incident report (insurance form) to be completed with the safety staff (Team Mom will have copy and it is on our website for download). When an injury results in a visit to a doctor then a release note from that physician will be required before the child is allowed to return to practice or games.



### **CONCUSSION PROTOCOL**



Output All coaches and safety personnel are trained to identify concussions through USA Football yearly

Description of the last 5 years keeping our concussion injury rate under 2%

Output Any player suspected of a concussion will be pulled from the field immediately and referred for further diagnosis.

Output Any player with concussion diagnosis must complete the concussion protocol before they are allowed to return to the field






